## 2025 CSF/CHS Hernia Case Competition

The Canadian Hernia Society (CHS) is proud to announce that we are accepting submissions for the 5th Annual Resident & Fellow Hernia Case Presentation for the 2025 Canadian Surgery Forum in Montreal.

We are accepting any interesting or difficult hernia cases. CHS will select 4 cases to be presented at the Canadian Surgery Forum (CSF). If selected, residents/fellows will have time to present their case followed by a couple minutes for discussion with the audience and moderators. Presenters must be available to present in person in Montreal.

Cases selected and judged based on the following criteria:

- 1. Originality
- 2. Embodying principles of hernia/abdominal wall repair
- 3. Educational value
- 4. Quality of presentation content (e.g. scans, photos, videos etc.)

Your submission should be in word format addressing the following:

- 1. Case Summary (Max: 500 words)
  - a. Title, presenter(s), staff sponsor, university affiliation
  - b. Case presentation (H&P, relevant investigations, and imaging)
  - c. Pre-operative interventions (if applicable)
  - d. Operative interventions
  - e. Post-operative course
  - f. Outcomes
- 2. Up to three points of discussion justifying your surgical approach to facilitate discussion amongst moderators and audience (Max: 100 words)
- 3. Why your case should be selected (Max: 100 words)

## The deadline for submissions is June 1, 2025. Please submit your cases to <u>csf@cags-accg.ca</u>.

All submissions will be blinded before review by the selection committee. All applicants will be notified of the committee's decision by June 30, 2025.

Conference registration, transport, and accommodations are/are not covered. There will be a prize for the top presentation at the end of the session.
