

1. How much is registration for Connect6ix?

Connect6ix is a free networking opportunity exclusive to Toronto CREW members.

3. How does Connect6ix work?

You'll be grouped with 6 – 8 Toronto CREW members who wish to meet in a similar way as you based on survey responses (in person vs virtual, preferred time of day). Other factors may be taken into consideration such as expertise, desired outcome, etc. Each month a designated Group Lead (see #9) will coordinate the meeting time, location, topics of conversation, etc.

4. How long is the commitment to Connect 6ix?

The goal is to meet with your 2026 Connect6ix group over the year on a monthly or bi-monthly basis, so that you have the chance to build strong relationships in an intimate setting. After 2026, new Connect6ix will be formed for new introductions and connections.

5. How do the groups connect?

We will connect you via email with your 2026 Connect6ix Group and designate a Group Lead to organize the first meetup. From there, it will be up to the group to decide when and where you'd like to meet!

6. Can we join after groups have been assigned?

Please reach out to a Connect6ix organizer (contact details below) if you are new to Toronto CREW or interested in joining after the groups have been assigned.

7. How do the groups decide on theme, topics to be discussed?

There is no set schedule or criteria for the groups – it is totally up to you! We will provide you with a resource library of suggested topics, articles, books, TED Talks for inspiration, if needed.

8. Can we bring a friend outside of Toronto CREW?

This is a members only resource and networking initiative to meet other members that you may not already be familiar with. If you are not part of Toronto CREW, we encourage you to join!

9. What is the responsibility of the “Group Lead?”

The person acting as the Group Lead will rotate every session and act as the host for that session. They may suggest topics of conversation, a theme, manage scheduling, calendar invites, location scouting, etc.

10. Do you have to have one topic or theme?

Groups are welcome to discuss and collaborate on any topic/theme for each session. Connect6ix offers total flexibility to discuss whatever is of interest to the group.

11. Do we always have to meet at the same time?

No, groups can schedule sessions based on what is most convenient for the members of their group.

12. Can you leave a group if you aren’t a good fit?

You are never obligated to stay in a group that you don’t feel is a good fit. Requests for changes may be limited to avoid over complications, but feel free to reach out to a Connect6ix organizer to discuss further.

13. Can you be a member of more than one group?

You will be assigned one group for the 2026 Connect6ix cohort.
